Yes already!! This year's Party will be on Saturday 5 December at the Zaretzky's in Banjup. More details to come over the next couple of months.







Yamaha Motor Europe has unveiled an official, limited edition replica of the PETRONAS Yamaha Sepang Racing Team YZR-M1

Yamaha Motor Europe has teamed up with Yamaha Austria Racing Team (YART) and Petronas to create a new limited-edition, track-only version of the YZF-R1 that apes the look of the Petronas Yamaha MotoGP bikes ridden by Fabio Quartararo and Franco Morbidelli this year.

Despite the fact that the Petronas Yamaha riders are currently showing the works team how it's done in MotoGP there are plenty of clues that it's the prospect of having Valentino Rossi's legendary '46' plastered on the front of next year's Petronas machine that's really sparked the project. It's said to be celebrating the 46th anniversary of Petronas, 46 of the bikes are due to be made and the price in Europe is €46,000 (about AU \$76,000).



Spec-wise, the bikes are dripping with top-end kit. A carbon-fibre race fairing complete with MotoGPstyle winglets and the Petronas livery sits atop a machine with full Ohlins suspension – FGRT 2 road and track forks, a TTX shock and a race steering damper – and a factory kit exhaust. A quick-change rear wheel system is added to make tyre swaps faster, the footpegs are replaced with race versions and a quick-action throttle controls an engine equipped with a racing ECU.

Brembo GP4-RX calipers and T-Drive discs deal with the stopping, mounted on Marchesini wheels with Michelin racing slicks. There's no word yet whether there's any headed our way but buyers will also get a matching KYT helmet, a Petronas polo shirt and a future VIP pass for the MotoGP round of their choice.






