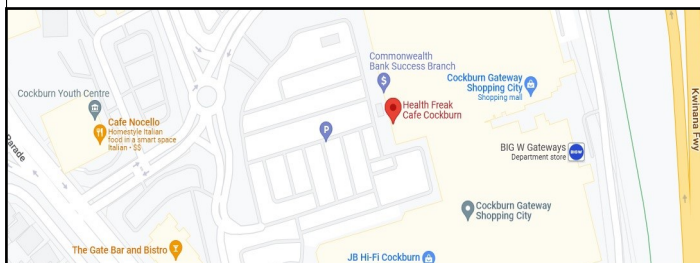

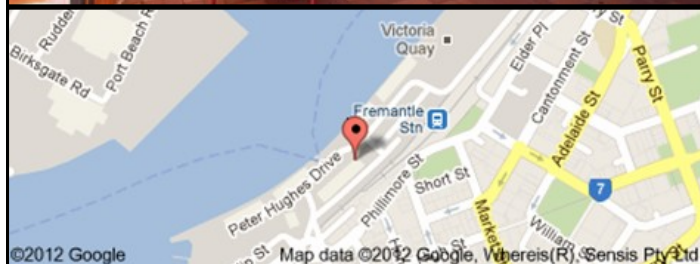

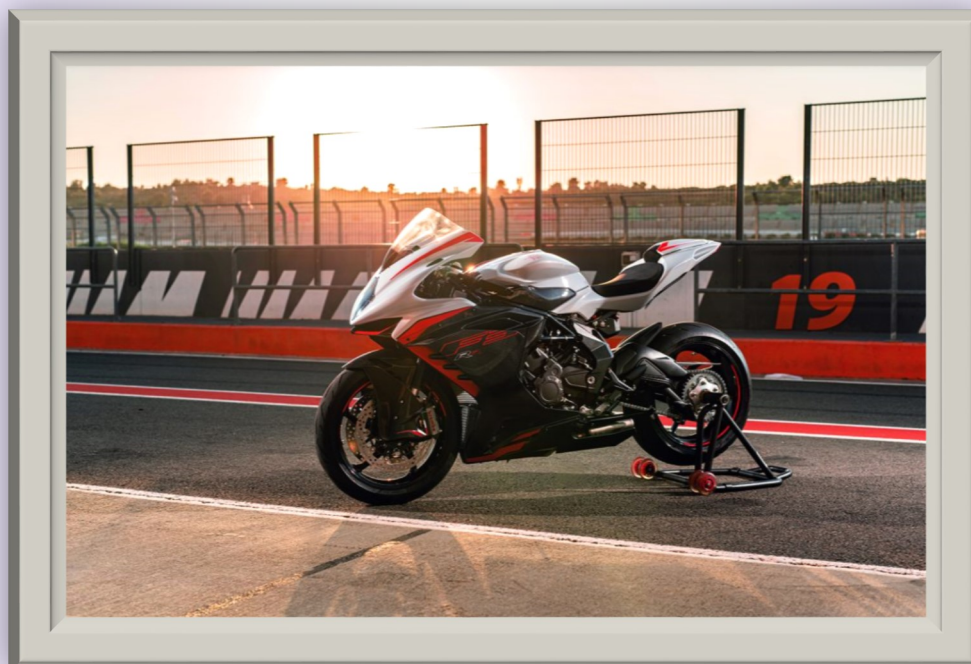
The 2022 MV Agusta F3 RR is arriving now in limited quantities and will be on Australian dealership floors from 2nd May onwards

The “Trepistoni” engine has undergone constant development which has led to a significant improvement by reducing internal friction and increasing the smoothness of riding without sacrificing its intense character.



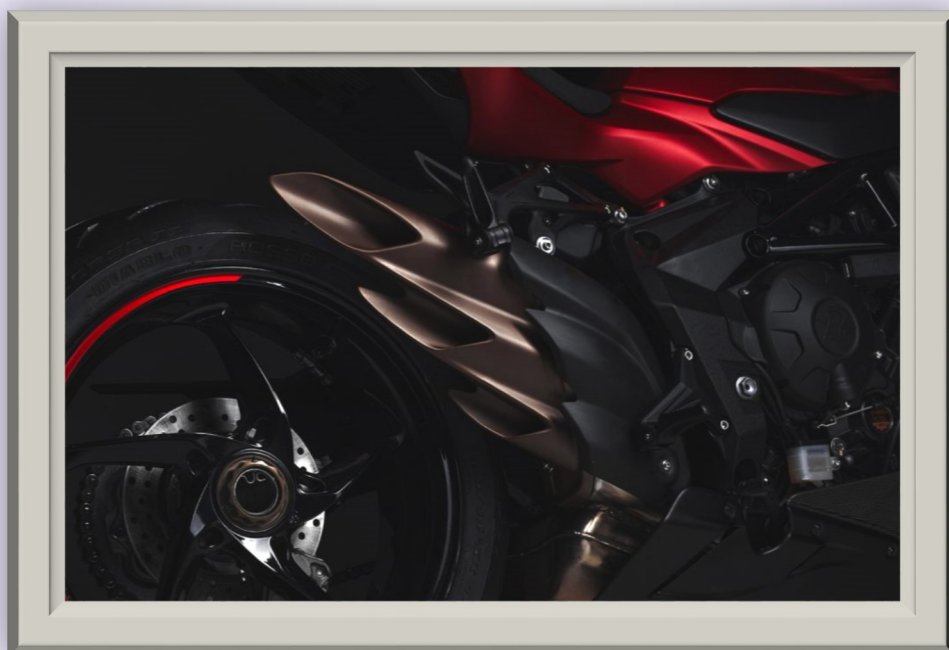
THE RACING KIT

MV Agusta's F3 RR is an extreme performance bike. Since everything can be improved, the customer is therefore offered the opportunity to embellish and transform the stock MV Agusta F3 RR into a unique bike with a special kit that includes additional CNC machined components (such as fuel cap, brake and clutch levers) along with a seat cover that turns the bike into a single-seater. The real gem of the kit, however, is the Akrapovič titanium exhaust – road approved – supplied with a dedicated control unit, which boosts the power up to 155hp and reduces the weight from 173 to 165 kg (dry).
